CODE OF PERSONAL CONDUCT

In order to insure the safety of each Mission volunteer and to support the Mission Objectives, the NCMOH Leadership Team has established the following rules:

1. Mission volunteers must attend planning meetings held prior to departure, as well as meetings in Nicaragua.
2. Mission volunteers will reside within the school compound on site.
3. Mission volunteers must abide by curfew regulations, i.e., being inside the school compound by set times and must follow necessary instructions issued by Mission Leadership.
4. Use / purchase / sale of alcohol and/or controlled substances is prohibited.
5. While traveling and while on site, volunteers will participate only in Mission-sanctioned activities, without attempting to further their own personal interests.
6. Mission volunteers will work cooperatively and display respect for co-workers: adults and students, Americans and those of other nationalities.
7. Appropriate Mission attire is mandatory while traveling to and from Nicaragua and also during the entire Mission and other Mission activities.
8. Mission volunteers will support and exhibit understanding of the values and objectives expressed in the NCMOH Constitutions and Bylaws:

NCMOH Constitution

ARTICLE 1, SECTION 2: OBJECTIVES

--To increase intercultural awareness and understanding between the citizens of the Northern New York area and the citizens of others parts of the world.

--To maintain a working partnership with developing areas (such as Nicaragua) in order to complete projects which strengthen both communities.

--To promote education throughout the life cycle in support of human development.

--To develop and expand the interest of our community, and to build on values promoting compassion, sharing, responsibility, and respect through Mission of Hope activities.

--To encourage Mission participants and supporters to make life choices based on a deeper understanding of human needs.
