North Country Mission of Hopesm CODE OF PERSONAL CONDUCT

In order to insure the safety of each Mission volunteer, and to support the Mission Objectives, the following rules have been established.

1. Mission volunteers must attend planning meetings held prior to departure, as well as meetings on site in Nicaragua.
2. Mission volunteers will reside within the Nicasa compound.
3. Mission volunteers must abide by curfew regulations, i.e., lights out by set times, and must follow necessary instructions issued by Mission Leadership.
4. Use/purchase/sale of alcohol and/or controlled substances is prohibited at all times.
5. While traveling and while on-site, volunteers will participate only in Mission-sanctioned activities, without attempting to further their own personal interests.
6. Mission volunteers will work cooperatively and display respect for co-workers: adults and students, Americans and those of other nationalities.
7. Mission volunteers will support and exhibit understanding of the values and objectives expressed in the North Country Mission of Hope Constitution and Bylaws.
