Specific food items:

Bottled water
Granola bars, saltine crackers
Jars of Peanut butter
Packages of crackers and peanut butter, Packages of crackers and cheese
100% juices-
Nuts- almonds, peanuts, Dried fruit, raisins
Canned foods: ONLY canned chicken, canned tuna, canned vegetables and fruits- preferably with a Pop off tab (still no electricity as of this news release)

Baby diapers, Baby wipes
Feminine Hygiene products, Adult Depends and supplies
5 gal. Cleaning bucket, mops, bleach, disinfectant household cleaners
28 oz. Bottle disinfectant dish soap
50 oz. Liquid Laundry Detergent
14 oz. Can insect repellent
Air Freshener (super odor) and odor removers
Lysol disinfectant sprays
Clothes pins and 50 ft. clothesline
