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CODE OF PERSONAL CONDUCT

In order to insure the safety of each Mission volunteer and to support the Mission Objectives, the NCMOH Leadership Team has established the following rules:

- 1. Mission volunteers must attend planning meetings held prior to departure, as well as meetings in Nicaragua.
- 2. Mission volunteers will reside within the school compound on site.
- 3. Mission volunteers must abide by curfew regulations, i.e., being inside the school compound by set times and must follow necessary instructions issued by Mission Leadership.
- 4. Use / purchase / sale of alcohol and/or controlled substances is prohibited.
- 5. While traveling and while on site, volunteers will participate only in Mission-sanctioned activities, without attempting to further their own personal interests.
- 6. Mission volunteers will work cooperatively and display respect for co-workers: adults and students, Americans and those of other nationalities.
- 7. Appropriate Mission attire is mandatory while traveling to and from Nicaragua and also during the entire Mission and other Mission activities.
- 8. Mission volunteers will support and exhibit understanding of the values and objectives expressed in the NCMOH Constitutions and Bylaws:

- --To maintain a working partnership with developing areas (such as Nicaragua) in order to complete projects which strengthen both communities.

- -- To develop and expand the interest of our community, and to build on values promoting compassion, sharing, responsibility, and respect through Mission of Hope activities.
- --To encourage Mission participants and supporters to make life choices based on a deeper understanding of human needs.
